
BEDGARD POSITIONING


We recommend that the bed sensor pad is positioned on the bed in one of three places depending on the patient and type of sensor pad.






For high-risk ambulant or semi-ambulant patients, the sensor pad should be placed on top of the mattress at the shoulder area (see section A on the illustration) for an early warning. The alarm will be activated when the patient sits up.

N.B. We do not recommend this position for patients weighing <40kg. Instead, place at the lumbar position.



For lower-risk ambulant patients, the optimal position for the sensor pad is at the lumbar region (see section B on the illustration). In this position, the sensor pad will alarm when the patient stands up to leave the bed.



The undermattress sensor pad should be positioned underneath the mattress where the patients hips would be (please refer to section B on the illustration above).

Whilst this is the recommended position, the undermattress pad may also operate effectively at the mid-back position - please assess on a case by case basis and only proceed if you are fully satisfied that the alarm will be triggered when the patient gets off the bed.
